

Happy Returns Daylily (*Hemerocallis* 'Happy Returns')

This easily grown daylily blooms in early summer and again in the fall. It grows 1-1.5 feet tall and spreads as wide. The blooms may be 3.5 inches in diameter and feature lemon yellow ruffles. These perennials look great in mass and as a border.



Plant Care: Happy Returns likes full sun to part shade. Although it will generally grow in most soils, it prefers deep loamy soil. Spent flowers should be deadheaded for neatness. After 3-4 years, these daylilies should be divided in the fall for our climate. Occasionally, mites, aphids and thrips may appear. In some areas in the southeast, daylily rust is a problem; rust is a fungus that can be treated with a fungicide.

Watering: These daylilies tolerate summer heat and humidity well. They need deep watering in dry spells to keep foliage attractive.
