

Plantaginea Hosta (*Hosta plantaginea*)

This dependable perennial is grown both for its beautiful foliage and large, fragrant flowers, which open in late afternoon scenting the air with a honeysuckle-like fragrance. This low-maintenance hosta grows 1-1.5 feet tall with a 1.5-2 feet spread and is sometimes called August lily in reference to its late summer bloom time.



Plant Care: Plant in part to full shade in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils. Plants can be divided in spring or early autumn, but spring is easiest before new leaves emerge.
