

Big Blue Liriope (*Liriope muscari* 'Big Blue')

Liriope muscari is a perennial with evergreen grass like foliage and lilac purple flowers which produce single seeded berries on a spike in the fall. It is easy to grow, will spread and can be very attractive as a border or ground cover. It tolerates full sun and shade. Once established, it will also tolerate dry conditions.



Plant Care / Watering: Easy to care for. Will grow in average, medium and well-draining soil. When first planted water twice a week until established. In the winter cut back old foliage. This can be easily done with a lawn mower, weed whacker or by hand with clippers. This helps support lovely new growth in the spring. Fertilize in spring if it needs a boost. USA Hardiness Zone 6 to 10.
