

Lemon Lime Nandina
***Nandina domestica* 'Lemon Lime'**

Lemon Lime Nandina is a dense multi-stemmed evergreen shrub with a mounded form. Its relatively fine texture sets it apart from other landscape plants with less refined foliage. Lemon Lime Nandina will grow to be about 4 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 4 feet. It tends to fill out right to the ground. It grows at a medium rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 30 years. It has no significant negative characteristics.



Plant Care and Watering: This shrub does best in full sun to partial shade. It likes average to evenly moist conditions, but will not tolerate standing water. It is highly tolerant of urban pollution and will even thrive in inner city environments. This shrub will require occasional maintenance and upkeep, and is best pruned in late winter once the threat of extreme cold has passed.
