

Desert Eve Yarrow
***Achillea millefolium* 'Desyel'**

This yarrow is a compact perennial, early-blooming, variety with lemon-yellow flowers held above ferny foliage. It is the perfect size for containers, or at the front of a sunny border or butterfly garden. Good for cut bouquets, fresh or dried. The dried seed heads feed overwintering birds. It is heat loving, waterwise, and seldom grazed by deer.



Plant Maintenance and Care: It thrives in lean to average, well-drained soil. Water deeply, regularly in first growing season to establish root system. Once established in landscape, it tolerates periodic dry spells; continue to water container plants regularly, when soil surface becomes dry. For a tidy appearance, remove spent flower stems. It grows quickly and reaches 14 to 18 in. tall and wide.
